Our parish now subscribes to a revolutionary online platform which provides the best in Catholic audio talks, movies, ebooks, and

It's available 24/7 thus allowing you to put time aside when it's best for you.

You will be asked to fill out a registration form and create a password for your email address. **There is no charge**. Once you have registered you'll have access to all the material on FORMED.

You also can install FORMED through an app. Learn more at <u>app.formed.org</u>. Our parish code is P8DGQ8.

#### Faith Formation Registration

Registration notices have been mailed to all current Faith Formation participants. All first-time faith formation families must register in person. Those registering for first grade must attend a special "introductory session" before accepting the child's registration. As in the past, a \$50 deposit is needed at the time of registration. Credit cards are accepted. Newly registered children must present a baptism certificate at the time of registration.
